



Cold Creek Flyfishers

The club was established in 1976, and has a leasehold on a section of Cold Creek in Northumberland County. This water is being developed into a superb fishery for naturally reproduced brown and brook trout. A no-kill, single barbless hook fly fishing only policy is in effect on the preserve.

Meetings are held on the second Monday of each month from October to April at Bayside Secondary School in Belleville. These meetings include presentations by guest speakers, instruction in fly fishing and fly tying, films, etc.

One of the main objectives of the club is conservation of wild trout streams. We are actively involved in stream rehabilitation and improvement projects in the Lower Trent area.
